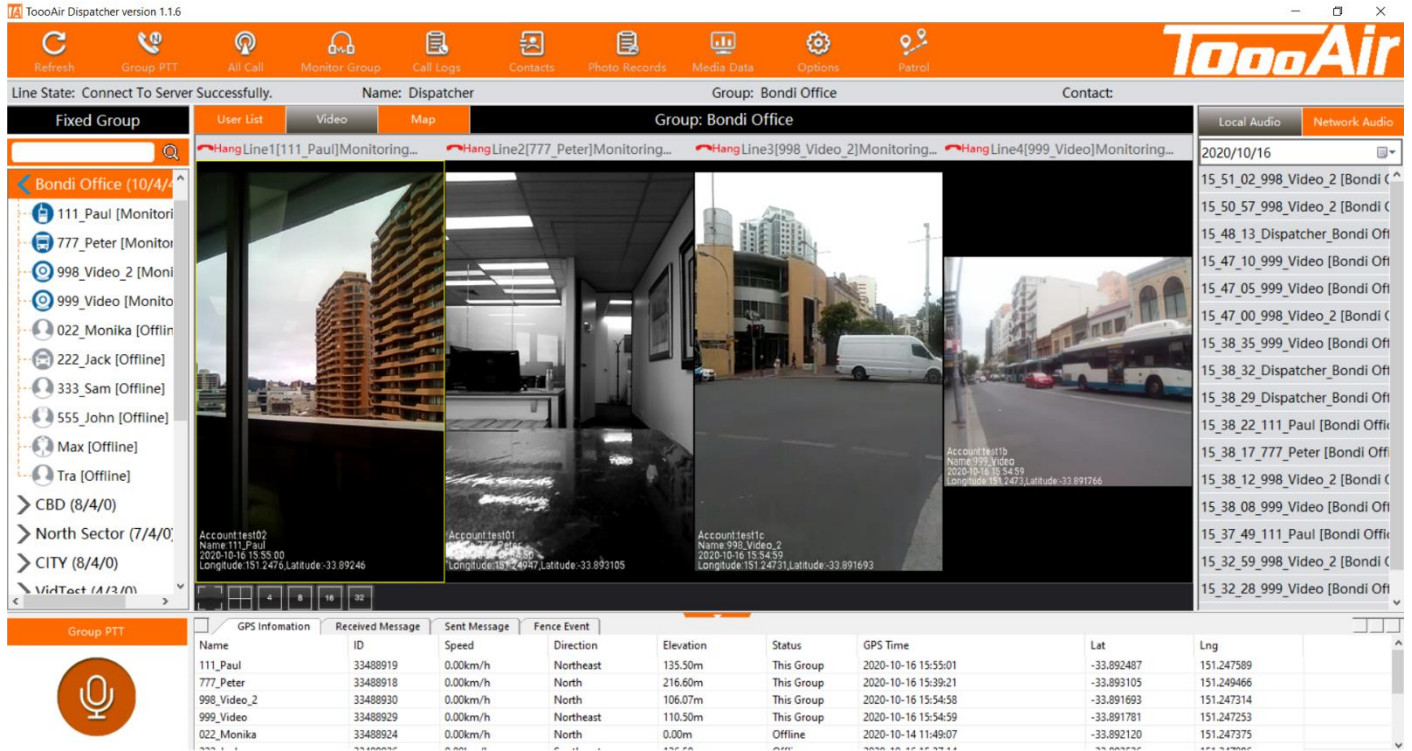

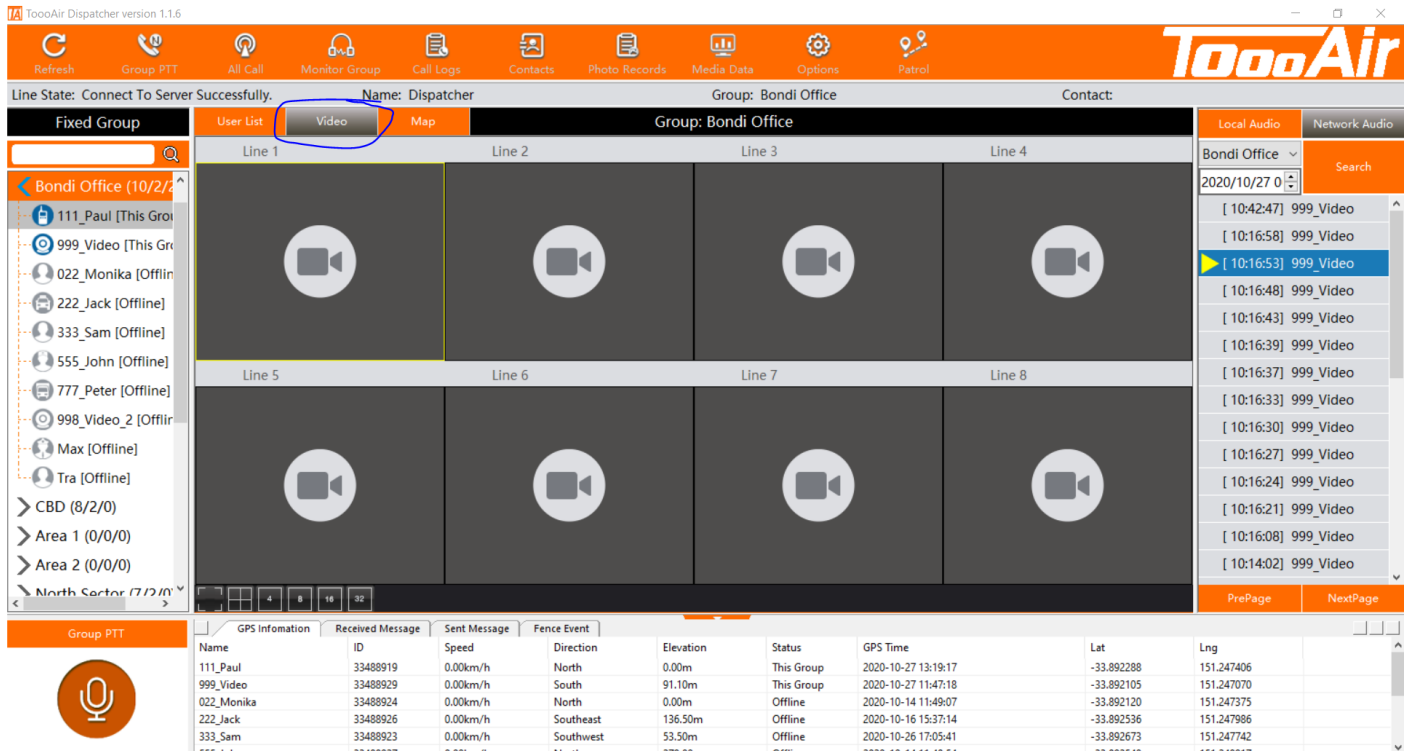

This Quick Start Guide is current with TooAir Video Dispatcher Version 1.1.6

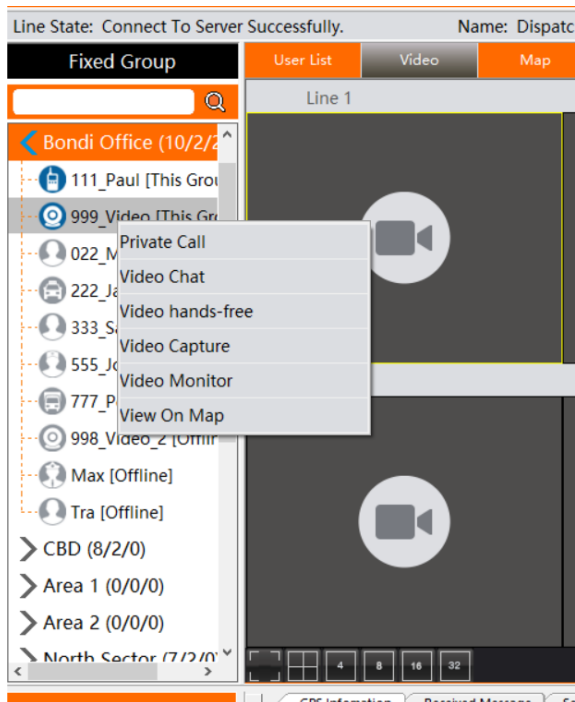
GETTING STARTED

Once signed into the Dispatcher your display should be currently viewing the User List. Left click Video to display the Video tab.



Live Streaming

From the Fixed Group pane, double left click a user and select a video call option. The options listed are;



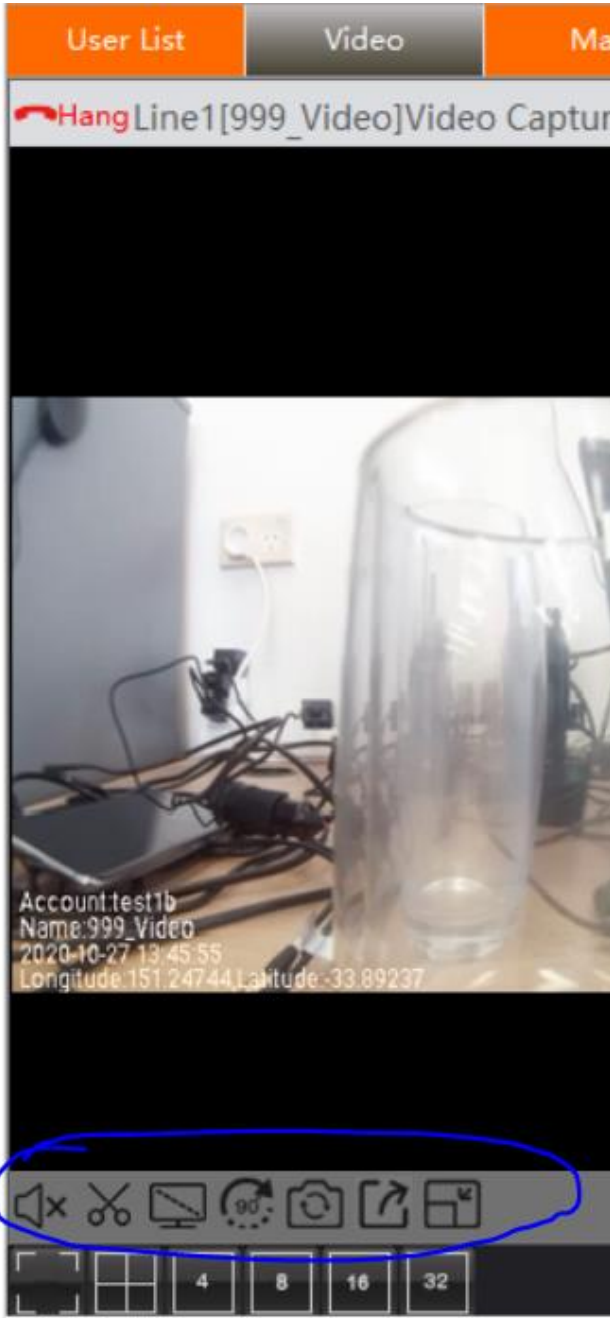
Video Chat – requires the body worn camera user to accept call

Video hands free - starts live video feed on in-ward facing camera

Video Capture - starts live video feed with outward facing camera

Video Monitor - starts live video feed with outward facing camera, without notifying user

Live Stream Interaction

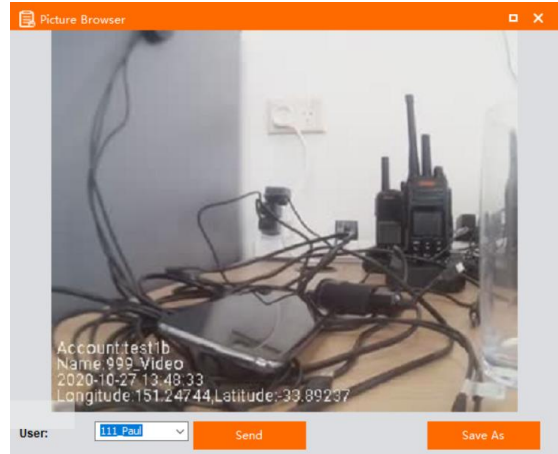


End Live Stream - You can end a Live Stream by left clicking



Mute – Left click to mute/unmute the live stream

Screenshot – Left click to take a snapshot of the current live stream



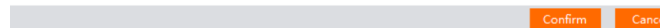
You can select a user to send the snapshot to or save the snapshot to local HDDs.

Resolution – Left click to adjust different live stream resolution, the resolution can be adjusted based off cellular connectivity for a smooth stream

Rotate – Left click to rotate the live stream 90degrees

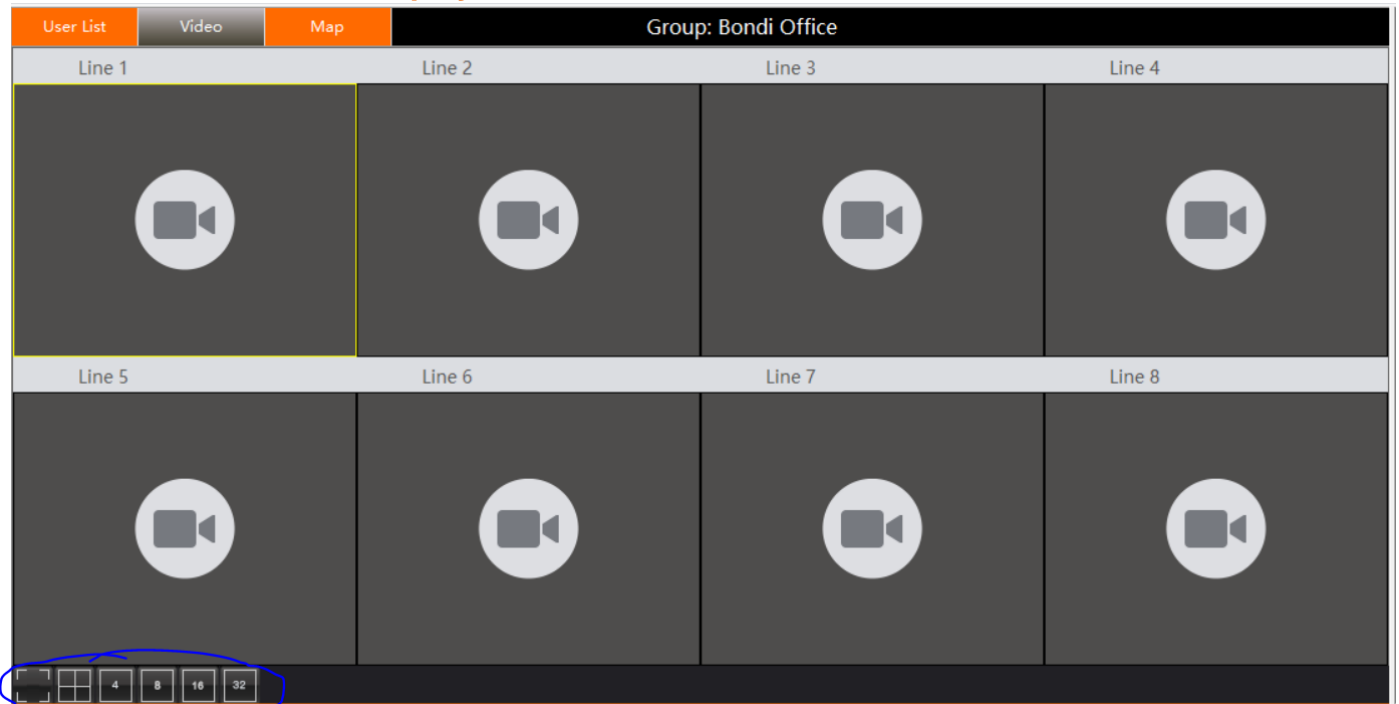
Switch Camera – Left click to change from the main outward facing camera to the inward facing camera

Video Distribute – Left click to share the live stream to another user using the TooAir video application



Display Settings – Left click to adjust the scale of the live stream displayed to the dispatcher

Customize Live Stream Displays



The live feed displays can be customized by selecting the different options located in the bottom left-hand corner. Increasing or decreasing the size of the live feeds and how many streams can be viewed at once of a maximum of 32. Please note if you select Full Screen, pressing ESCAPE key exits Full Screen mode.

RECORDINGS

The live stream recordings are saved to the TooAir servers for 6 months and to the local Dispatcher PC (Please refer to Save Video Settings for local recordings).

Access Recordings



The recordings can be accessed via the Dispatcher by left clicking Media Data

Once displayed you can view either the Local Video recordings or the TooAir Cloud recordings.

Local Dispatcher Recordings

Left clicking Local Video and selecting a date and left clicking refresh will display the recordings from the local Dispatcher PC. Please note the “Save Video” option located under Options > Video Settings must be ticked for this feature.

Double left clicking the video recordings will begin playing the recording.

TooAir Cloud Recordings



Left clicking Net Media and selecting a date and left clicking “Select All” will display the recordings from the TooAir cloud.

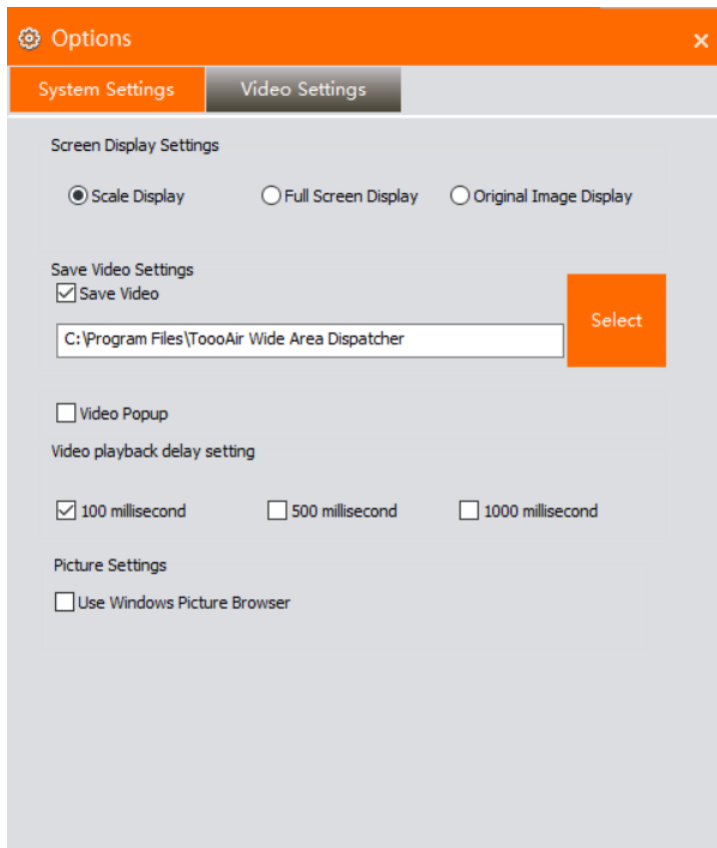
Left clicking Download will download the recording from the cloud, you can select multiple recordings and left click Download located at the bottom of the page. Once clicking Download select a save path for the file.

Left clicking Play will play the recording directly from the TooAir cloud without downloading the file.

SETTINGS

The Video Settings can be accessed via

- Options 
- Video Settings 



From the Video Settings display tab, you can customize how the TooAir Dispatcher interacts with the live video streams.

Screen Display Settings

Customize how the live stream is displayed in the Dispatcher, by Default Scale Display is selected.

Save Video Settings

You can save the live stream to the Dispatcher PC. Tick the Save Video box and select a location for the recordings to be saved. The recordings are saved as compressed MP4 files and the recording space usage should roughly reflect 1GB per 1-hour live stream.

Video Popup

The Video Display tab can be moved around the screen or to a second monitor. Tick the Video popup box to move the Video display area.

Video Playback Delay Settings

The live stream feed can be delayed to the Dispatcher, by default 500 milliseconds is ticked.
